Ray Christner, PsyD, NCSP, licensed psychologist, is founder and CEO of Cognitive Health Solutions. He has published and presented on CBT, school based mental health, neurocognitive assessments, and anxiety in the classroom. He was Pennsylvania school psychologist of the year in 2005.

Rachel Brown, PhD, NCSP, licensed psychologist, is associate professor of school psychology at the University Of Southern Maine. She has published and presented on RTI, CBM, reading achievement, and learning disabilities. She has previously taught both special education and general education.

John Kelly, PhD, NCSP, is the current president for NASP and has been the NASP PD coordinator, has published and presented on mental health services in schools, bullying, special education funding, and RTI. He was New York school psychologist of the year in 2001 and NASP school psychologist of the year in 2007.

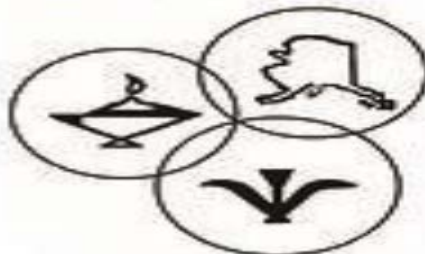
This fall ASPA conference will include:
